Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

'Do whatever he tells you.' This small but amazingly powerful statement echoes down the centuries to us today. Mary caught the attention of the servants at the wedding and she is trying to catch our attention today. I can see her standing beside me today and gently pointing to Jesus and whispering to me, *'Just do whatever he tells and asks you.'*



What is Jesus asking us to do? He is inviting us to follow him, he is asking us to love each other as he loves us and he is asking us to forgive each other. He is asking us to live like him in our ordinary daily lives; he is asking us to reach out and to care for those who are poor, homeless, alone, and hungry. He is asking us to be his followers and disciples. How do we do this? By following the example of Mary who did what God asked her to do! Today, may we listen to Mary, and do what Jesus asks each of us to do.

Attending Mass at St. Emile Parish

Welcome to St. Emile Parish. As we gather in faith, friendship, and brotherhood/sisterhood, each attendee is being asked to follow all current Provincial and St. Boniface Archdiocese Covid-19 protocols.

The Provincial Covid Restriction Order on Religious services or faith-based gatherings allows for cohorts of 25 people where there is complete separation. Each cohort is prevented from coming into close proximity with persons in another cohort during the service as well as when entering or leaving. There will be separate entrances at St. Emile. Please enter at the 2 Entrances (1 & 2) of the Church first. Once the church is full, attendees will be redirected to the outside South Entrances of the Chapel, and Parish Hall where mass will be live streamed. Mass attendance will be on a first come first served basis.

The province still requires that everyone self- screen prior to attending Mass and provide contact tracing information by signing in at all weekday and Sunday Masses.

Masks must be worn at all times in a manner that covers the mouth, nose, and chin without gapping.

“Nourish” Support Program for Caregivers – Starts January 17, 2022

Are you a caregiver that needs personal support? *Nourish* is a program designed to address the most important and commonly reported needs of family caregivers. *Nourish for Caregivers* content has been developed using a methodology built using evidence and insights and grounded in the Christian faith. Twelve 1.5-hour sessions (1 per month) that include: a topic (ex: stress), session overview, facilitating discussion and reflection, small group activity, sharing, and closing with prayer and intentions.
